incompatible teleological notions including proofs for the existence of a providential or designer god vitalism and animism opposition to mechanism and non teleological causation and anthropocentrism johnson addresses these misconceptions through an elaboration of aristotle s methodological statements as well as an examination of the explanations actually offered in the scientific works
